Why **are** you so far

\from the words
\of my **groan^{ing}**?

O my God,
I **cry**
\by day,
but
you **do not answer**,

and
\by night,
but
I **find** no rest.

3

Yet
you **are** holy,
enthron^{ed}
\on the praises
\of Israel.

4

\In you
our fathers **trusted**;

they **trusted**,
and
you **delivered** them.

5

\To you
they **cried**
and
were rescued;

\in you
they **trusted**
and
were not put
\to shame.

6

But
I **am** a worm
and
not a man,

scorn^{ed}
\by mankind
and
despis^{ed}
\by the people.

7

All
who see me
mock me;

they **make** mouths
\at me;
they **wag** their heads;

8

“He trusts
\in the LORD;
let
him **deliver** him;
let
him **rescue** him,

for
he **delights**
\in him!”

Yet
you **are** he
who took me
\from the womb;
you **made**
me **trust** you
\at my mother's breasts.

10

\On you
was I cast
\from my birth,

and
\from my mother's womb
you have been my God.

Be not far
\from me,

for
trouble is near,
and
there is none
\to help.

Many bulls encompass me;

strong bulls
\of Bashan
surround me;

13

they open wide their mouths
\at me,
like a ravening^{and} roaring lion.

14

I am poured out
like water,

and
all my bones are
\out of joint;

my heart is
like wax;
it is melted
\within my breast;

15

my strength is dried up
like a potsherd,

and
my tongue sticks
\to my jaws;

you lay me
\in the dust
\of death.

For
dogs encompass me;

a company
\of evildoers
encircles me;
they have pierced my hands^{and} feet—

17

I can count all my bones—
they stare^{and} gloat
\over me;

18

they divide my garments
\among them,

and
\for my clothing
they cast lots.

But
you, O LORD,
do not be far off!

O you
my help,
come quickly
\to my aid!

Deliver my soul
\from the sword,

my precious life
\from the power
\of the dog!

Save me
\from the mouth
\of the lion!
You **have rescued** me
\from the horns
\of the wild oxen!

I will tell
\of your name
\to my brothers;

\in the midst
\of the congregation
I will praise you:

who fear the LORD,
praise him!

All you offspring
\of Jacob,
glorify him,

and
stand
\in awe
\of him,

all you offspring
\of Israel!

he **has not despised** or **abhorred** the
affliction
\of the afflicted,

and
he **has not hidden** his face
\from him,

but
has heard,
when
he **cried**
\to him.

\From you
comes my praise
\in the great congregation;

my vows I **will perform**
\before those
who fear him.

The afflicted **shall eat** ^{and} **be satisfied**;

those
who seek him
shall praise the LORD!

May your hearts **live** forever!

All the ends
\of the earth
shall remember
and
turn
\to the LORD,

and
all the families
\of the nations
shall worship
\before you.

For
kingship **belongs**
\to the LORD,

and
he **rules**
\over the nations.

All the prosperous
\of the earth
eat ^{and} **worship**;

\before him
shall bow all
who go down
\to the dust,

even the one
who could not **keep** himself alive.

Posterity **shall serve** him;

it **shall be told**
\of the Lord
\to the **com^{ing}** generation;

they **shall come** ^{and} **proclaim** his
righteousness
\to a people yet unborn,
that
he **has done** it.
