**Let**  
them **be confounded**  
and  
**put**  
\<sup>to</sup> **shame**  
**that seek**  
\after my soul:

**let**  
them **be turned back**  
and

\to confusion  
**that devise** my hurt.

**Let**  
them **be**  
\as chaff  
\before the wind:

and  
**let**  
the angel  
\of the LORD  
**chase** them.

**Let**  
their way **be** dark and slippery:  
and  
**let**  
the angel  
\of the LORD  
**persecute** them.

7

For  
\without cause  
**have they hid**  
\for me  
their net  
\in a pit,  
**which**  
\without cause  
they **have digged**  
\for my soul.

8

**Let**  
destruction **come**  
\upon him  
\at unawares;  
and  
**let**  
his net  
**that**  
he **hath hid**  
**catch** himself:  
\into that very destruction

**let**  
him **fall**.

9

And  
my soul **shall be joyful**  
\in the LORD:  
it **shall rejoice**  
\in his salvation.

10

All my bones **shall say**,  
LORD,  
who **is**  
like unto thee,  
**which deliverest** the poor  
from him  
**that is** too strong  
for him,  
yea,  
the poor and the needy  
from him  
**that spoileth** him?

11

False witnesses **did rise up**;  
they **laid**  
to my charge  
things  
**that**  
I **knew** not.

12

They **rewarded** me evil  
for good  
to the **spoiling**  
of my soul.

13

But  
as for me,  
**when**  
they **were** sick,  
my clothing **was** sackcloth:  
I **humbled** my soul  
with **fasting**;  
and  
my prayer **returned**  
into mine own bosom.

14

I **behaved** myself  
**as though**  
he **had been** my friend or brother:  
I **bowed down** heavily,  
as one  
**that mourneth**  
for his mother.

15

But

in mine adversity  
they **rejoiced**,  
and **gathered** themselves together:  
yea,  
the abjects **gathered** themselves  
together  
against me,  
and  
I **knew** it not;  
they **did tear** me,  
and **ceased** not:

With hypocritical mockers  
in feasts,  
they **gnashed**  
upon me  
with their teeth.

17

LORD,  
how long **wilt thou look on?**  
**rescue** my soul  
from their destructions,  
my darling  
from the lions.

I **will give** thee **thanks**  
in the great congregation:  
I **will praise** thee  
among much people.

Let not  
them  
**that are** mine enemies  
wrongfully **rejoice**  
over me:  
neither  
**let**  
them **wink**  
with the eye  
**that hate** me  
without a cause.

For  
they **speak** not peace:  
but  
they **devise** deceitful matters

against them  
that are quiet  
in the land.

21

Yea,  
they opened their mouth wide  
against me,  
and  
said,  
Aha, aha,  
our eye hath seen it.

22

This thou hast seen,  
O LORD:  
keep not silence:  
O LORD,  
be not far  
from me.

23

Stir up thyself,  
and  
awake  
to my judgment,  
even  
unto my cause,  
my God and my LORD.

24

Judge me,  
O LORD my God,  
according to thy righteousness;  
and  
let  
them not rejoice  
over me.

25

Let  
them not say  
in their hearts,  
Ah,  
so would we have it:

let  
them not say,  
We have swallowed him up.

26

Let  
them be ashamed

and  
brought  
to confusion  
together  
that rejoice  
at mine hurt:

let  
them be clothed  
with shame and dishonour  
that magnify themselves  
against me.

Let  
them shout  
for joy,  
and  
be glad,  
that favour my righteous cause:

yea,

let

them say continually,

Let

the LORD be magnified,  
which hath pleasure  
in the prosperity  
of his servant.
