and  
**wither**  
|as <sup>ke</sup> the herb.  
\green

|| **Trust**  
|in <sup>be</sup> the LORD,  
and  
**do** | good;

so  
thou || **shalt dwell**  
|in the land,  
and  
thou || **shalt be fed.**  
\verily

|| **Delight** | thyself  
\also  
|in the LORD:

and  
he || **shall give** | the desires  
|thee |of heart.  
\thine

|| **Commit** | way  
|unto the LORD; \thy  
|| **trust**

**Fret** not thyself  
because of evildoers,  
neither  
**be** thou **envious**  
against the workers  
of iniquity.

For  
they **shall** soon **be cut down**  
like the grass,  
and  
**wither**  
as the green herb.

3

**Trust**  
in the LORD,  
and  
**do** good;  
so  
**shalt** thou  **dwell**  
in the land,  
and  
verily thou **shalt be fed**.

4

**Delight** thyself also  
in the LORD:  
and  
he **shall give** thee the desires  
of thine heart.

5

**Commit** thy way  
unto the LORD;  
**trust** also  
in him;  
and  
he **shall bring** it  
to pass.

6

And  
he **shall bring forth** thy righteousness  
as the light,  
and  
thy judgment  
as the noonday.

7

**Rest**  
in the LORD,  
and  
**wait** patiently  
for him:  
**fret** not thyself  
because of him  
**who prospereth**  
in his way,  
because of the man  
**who bringeth** wicked devices  
to pass.

8

**Cease**  
from anger,  
and  
**forsake** wrath:  
**fret** not thyself  
in any wise  
to do evil.

9

For  
evildoers **shall be cut off**:  
but  
those  
**that wait**  
upon the LORD,  
they **shall inherit** the earth.

10

For  
yet a little while,  
and  
the wicked **shall not be**:  
yea,  
thou **shalt** diligently **consider** his place,  
and  
it **shall not be**.

11

But  
the meek **shall inherit** the earth;  
and **shall delight** themselves  
in the abundance  
of peace.

12

The wicked **plotteth**  
\against the just,  
and  
**gnasheth**  
\upon him  
\with his teeth.

13

The LORD **shall laugh**  
\at him:  
for  
he **seeth**  
**that**  
his day **is coming**.

14

The wicked **have drawn out** the sword,  
and  
**have bent** their bow,  
\<sup>to</sup> **cast down** the poor and needy,  
and  
\<sup>to</sup> **slay** such  
**as** be  
\of upright conversation.

15

Their sword **shall enter**  
\into their own heart,  
and  
their bows **shall be broken**.

16

A little  
**that**  
a righteous man **hath**  
**is** better  
\than the riches  
\of many wicked.

17

For  
the arms  
\of the wicked  
**shall be broken**:  
but  
the LORD **upholdeth** the righteous.

18

The LORD **knoweth** the days  
\of the upright:  
and their inheritance **shall be**  
for ever.

19

They **shall not be ashamed**  
\in the evil time:  
and  
\in the days  
\of famine  
they **shall be satisfied**.

20

But the wicked **shall perish**,  
and the enemies  
\of the LORD  
**shall be**  
\as the fat  
\of lambs:  
they **shall consume**;  
\into smoke  
**shall they consume away**.

21

The wicked **borroweth**,  
and  
**payeth** not again:  
but  
the righteous **sheweth mercy**,  
and  
**giveth**.

22

For  
such  
**as** be **blessed**  
\of him  
**shall inherit** the earth;  
and  
they  
**that** be **cursed**  
\of him  
**shall be cut off**.

23

The steps  
\of a good man  
**are ordered**  
\by the LORD:

and  
he **delighteth**  
\in his way.

24

**Though**  
he **fall**,  
he **shall not be utterly cast down**:  
for  
the LORD **upholdeth** him  
\with his hand.

25

I **have been** young,  
and  
now **am** old;  
yet  
**have** I not **seen**  
the righteous **forsaken**,  
nor  
his seed **begging** bread.

26

He **is** ever **merciful**,  
and  
**lendeth**;  
and  
his seed **is blessed**.

27

**Depart**  
\from evil,  
and  
**do** good;  
and  
 **dwell**  
\for evermore.

28

For  
the LORD **loveth** judgment,  
and  
**forsaketh** not his saints;  
they **are preserved**  
for ever:  
but  
the seed  
\of the wicked  
**shall be cut off**.

29

The righteous **shall inherit** the land,  
and  
 **dwell** therein  
for ever.

30

The mouth  
\of the righteous  
 **speaketh** wisdom,  
and  
his tongue  **talketh**  
\of judgment.

31

The law  
\of his God  
 **is**  
\in his heart;  
none  
\of his steps  
 **shall slide**.

32

The wicked  **watcheth** the righteous,  
and  
 **seeketh**  
\<sup>to</sup>  **slay** him.

33

The LORD  **will** not  **leave** him  
\in his hand,  
nor  
 **condemn** him  
 **when** he  **is judged**.

34

**Wait**  
\on the LORD,  
and  
 **keep** his way,  
and  
he  **shall exalt** thee  
\<sup>to</sup>  **inherit** the land:  
 **when** the wicked  **are cut off**,  
thou  **shalt see** it.

I **have seen** the wicked  
in great power,  
and  
**spread<sup>ing</sup>** himself  
like a green bay tree.
