For<sup>ki</sup>  
mine iniquities are gone over mine  
head:  
\as<sup>ke</sup> an heavy burden

\for me.

My wounds stink and are corrupt<sup>fester</sup>  
\because of my foolishness.

I am troubled;  
I am bowed down greatly;  
I go  
\mourn<sup>ing</sup>  
\all the day long.

For<sup>ki</sup>  
my loins are filled  
\with a loathsome disease:  
and  
there is no soundness  
\in<sup>be</sup> my flesh.

I am feeble<sup>faint</sup>  
and sore<sup>badly</sup> broken<sup>crushed</sup>.  
I have roared  
\by reason  
\of the disquietness  
\of my heart.

LORD,  
all my desire is  
\before thee;  
and  
my groaning is not hid  
\from thee.

My heart panteth,  
my strength faileth me:  
\as for the light  
\of mine eyes,
