


# Types of Verbs


## Examples

### Intransitive Verbs

 <p style="text-align: center;">intransitive verb</p> <p style="text-align: center;">S   V</p> <p style="text-align: center;">\prep + obj (adverbial function)</p>	<p>An <u>intransitive verb</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• is an <u>action</u> verb</li> <li>• has <b>no</b> direct object</li> <li>• expresses action <u>without an object</u></li> </ul>

Genesis 17:17a


"Abraham **fell** on his face and **laughed**."

 <p>Abraham   <b>fell</b> \on his face ← prep. phrase tells "where" he fell</p> <p>and <b>laughed</b></p>	<p><u>Diagram</u></p> <p>Abraham <b>fell</b> \on his face and <b>laughed</b>.</p>

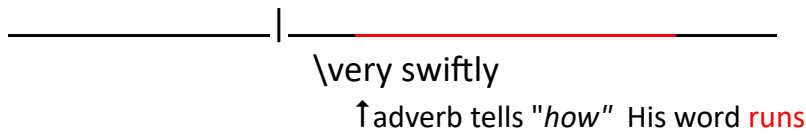
Genesis 18:12a

" His word **runs** very swiftly."



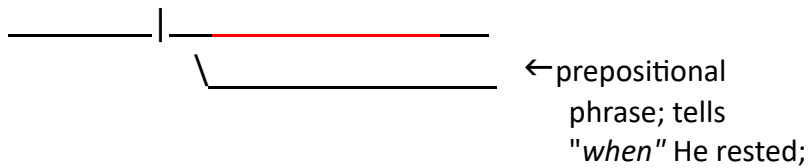

"He **rested** on the seventh day."

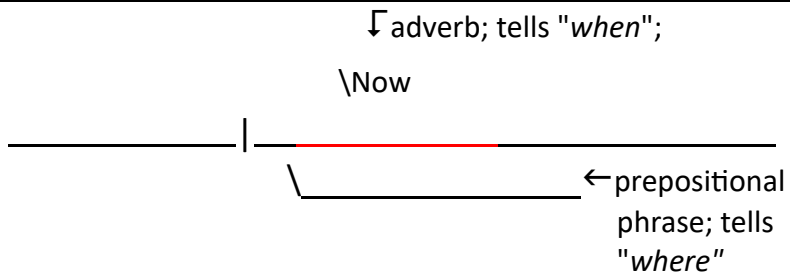

"Now a river **flowed** out of Eden.

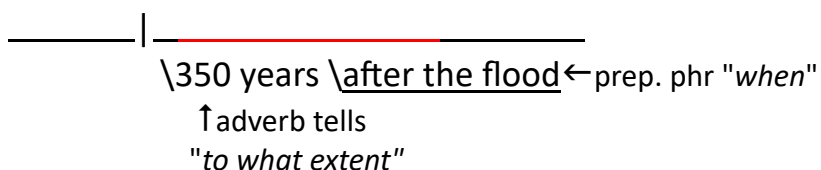


Diagram
